SUBJECT: Approval for Expediting Single Scoped Background Investigations (SSBI) for Soldiers Reclassifying into Military Intelligence (MI) Military Occupational Specialties (MOS)

1. References:

- c. DA Pam 611-21, Military Occupational Classification and Structure, 22 Jan 07.

2. Background. An interim Top Secret/Sensitive Compartmented Information (TS/SCI) eligibility must be granted prior to attending Military Intelligence Advance Individual Training (AIT). At specified weeks of AIT, Soldiers will require a final TS/SCI. In accordance with the DA PAM 611-21, certain Military Intelligence occupational specialties require a final TS/SCI security clearance eligibility to be awarded the MOS. Soldiers who do not have the requisite clearance for attendance to AIT and also at certain intervals of AIT are placed in a security hold status pending final TS/SCI security clearance eligibility.

3. Policy. Effective immediately, soldiers reclassifying into a MI MOS will be expeditiously processed for the required security clearance. Expeditious processing will be handled as follows:

- a. An SSBI will be submitted to the Personnel Security Investigation Center of Excellence (PSI-CoE) through the Personnel Security Investigations Portal. The PSI-CoE will internally expedite the processing of the background investigation package.

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b. The PSI-CoE will ensure the term "MI Soldier" is in the position title of the Agency Use Block (AUB) and request priority handling from the Office of Personnel Management. The PSI-CoE will request Advance National Agency Check (NAC) results be sent to the Army Central Adjudication Facility (CCF) to support the interim SCI determination.

c. The CCF will expedite the interim determination and final adjudication of the expedited case.
