



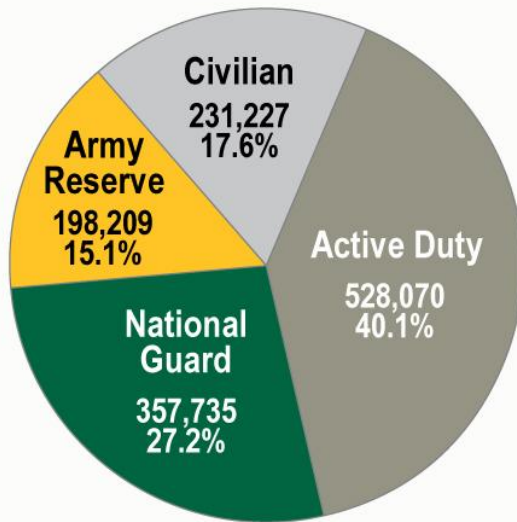

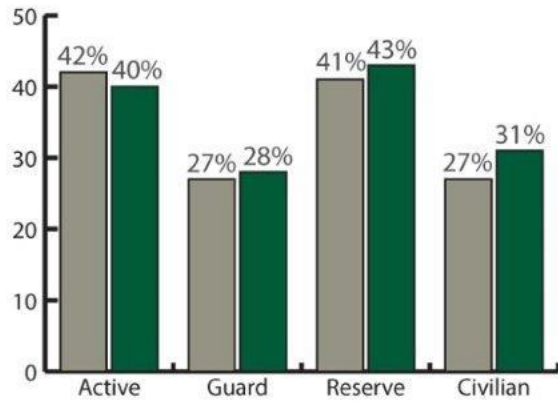
U.S. Military Academy

As of September 2013, there were 4,486 Cadets enrolled at the U.S. Military Academy (17% females and 28% racial/ethnic minorities).

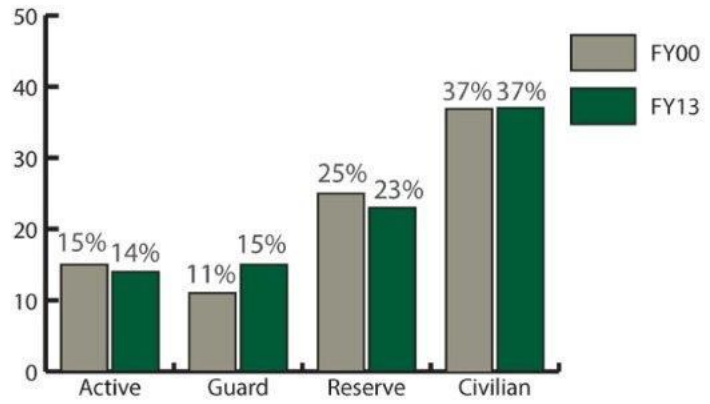

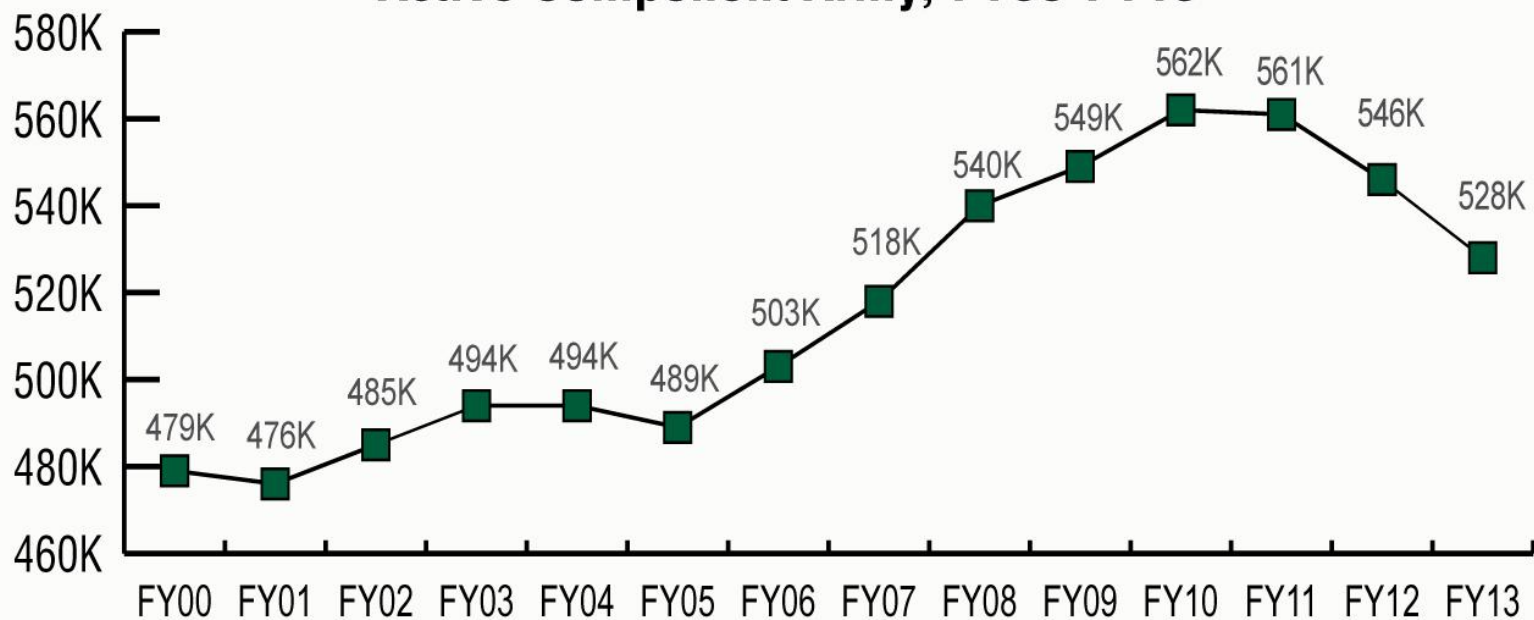

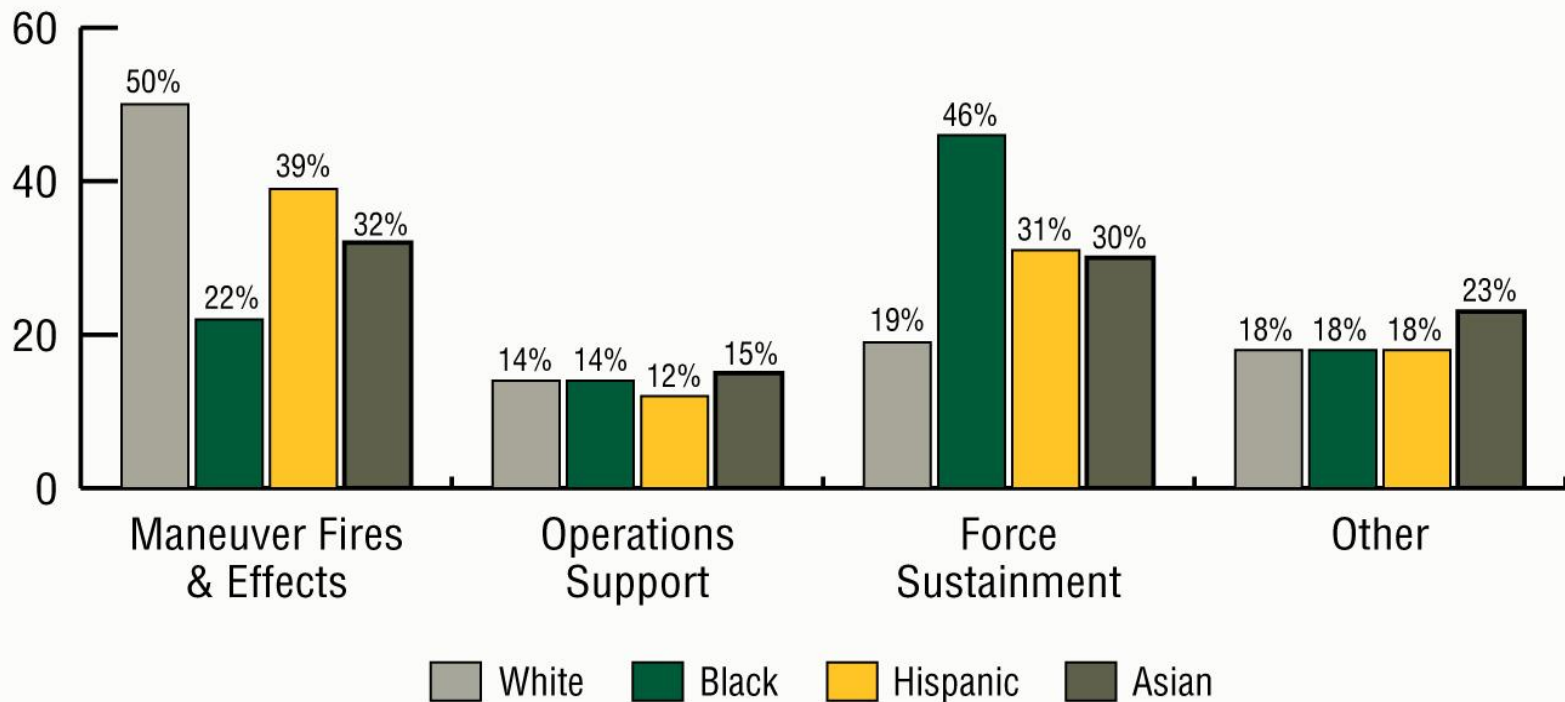

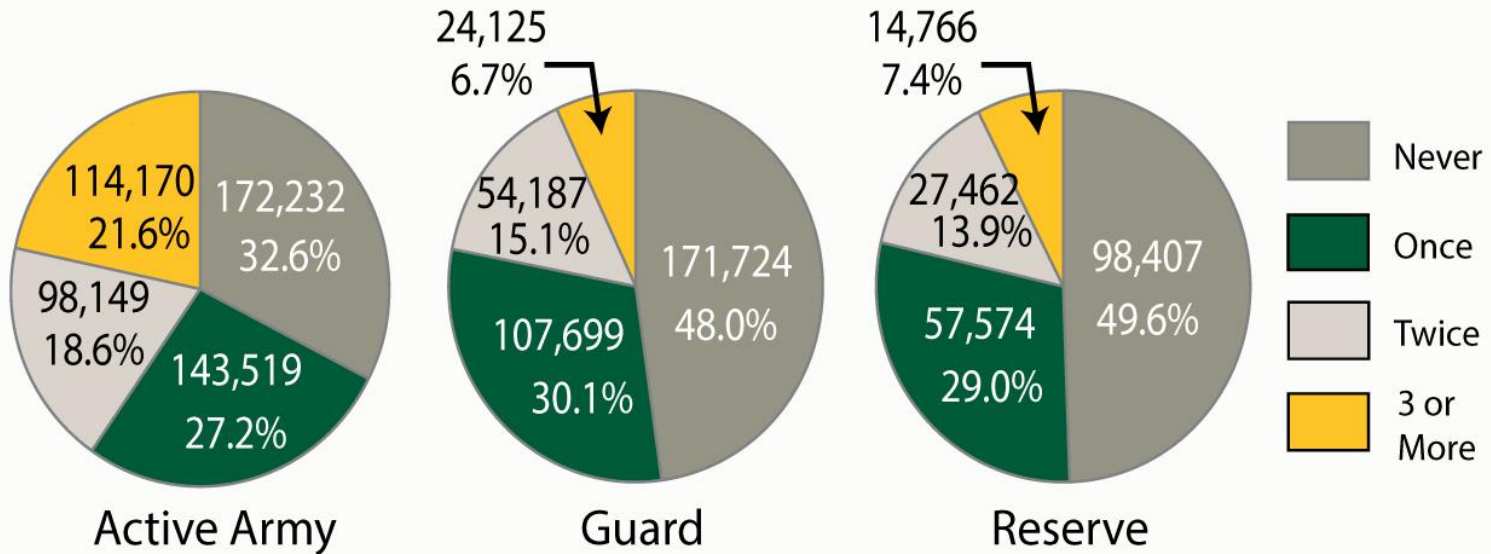

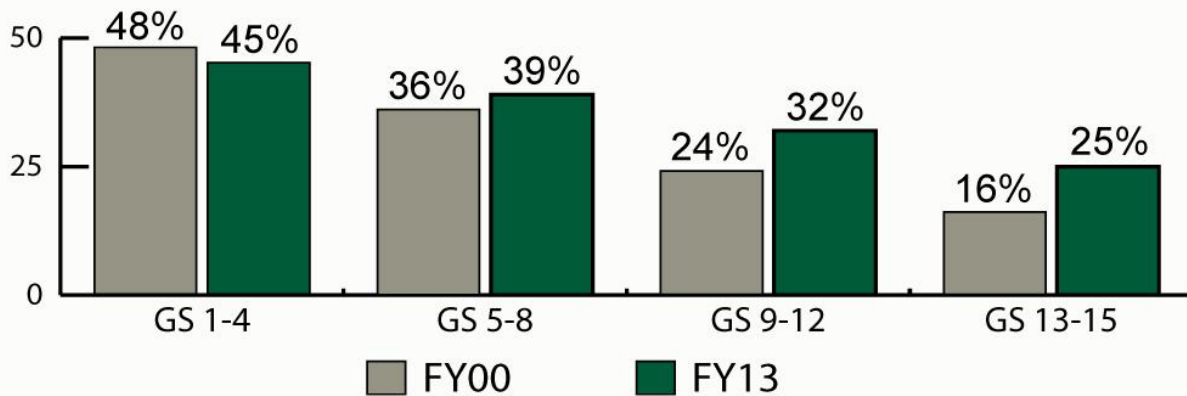

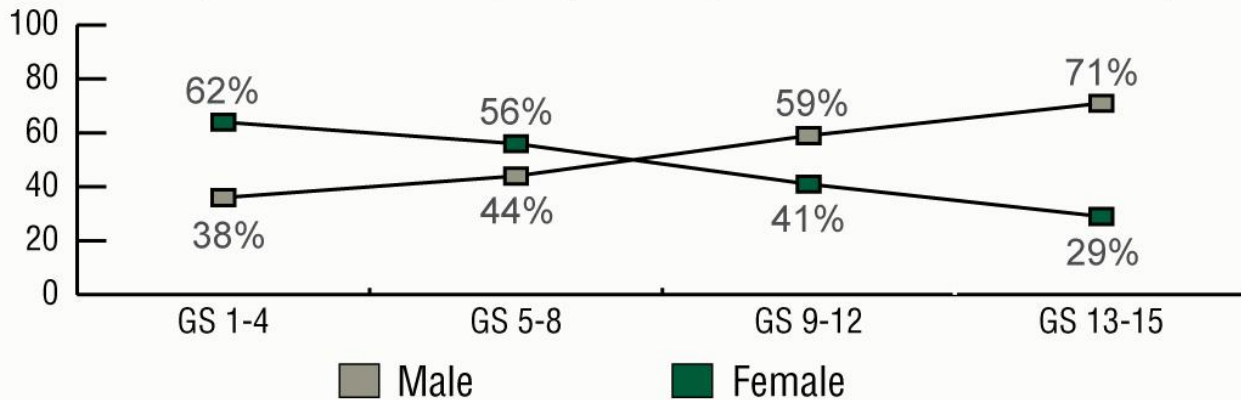
▲ Civilian Employees* (excludes National Guard Civilians) Minority Employees by Grade, FY00 vs FY13

Army Civilian Employees by Gender and Grade, FY13

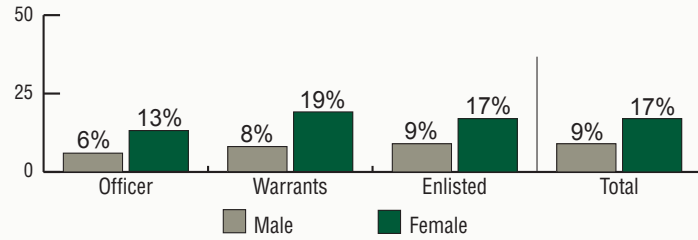

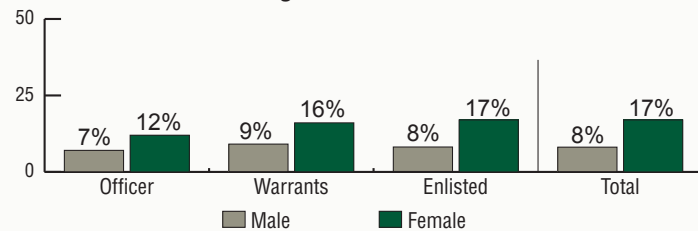

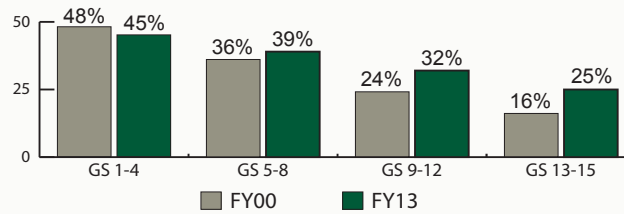

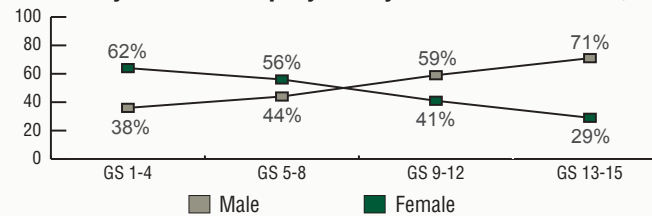

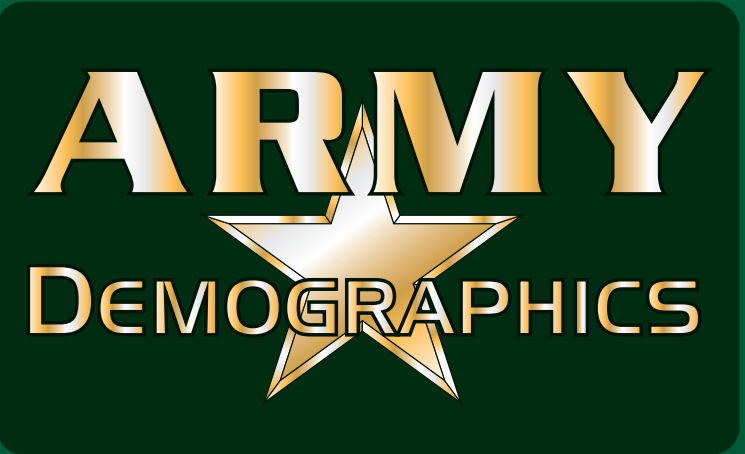

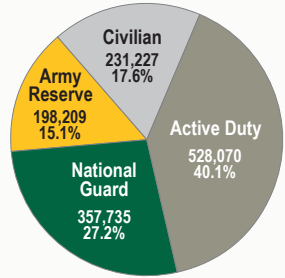

Total Strength of the Army



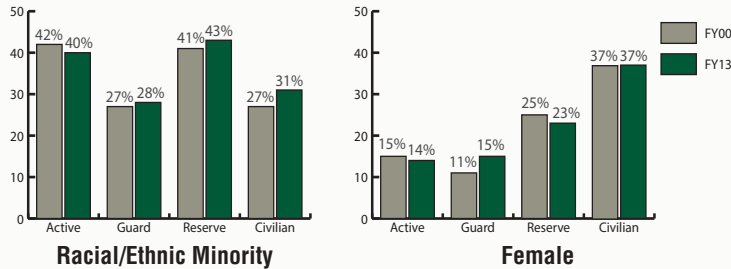

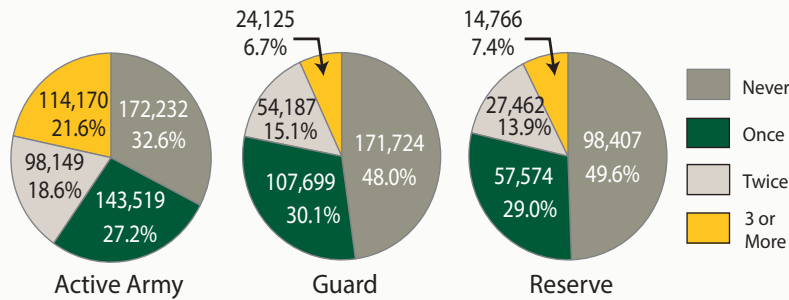

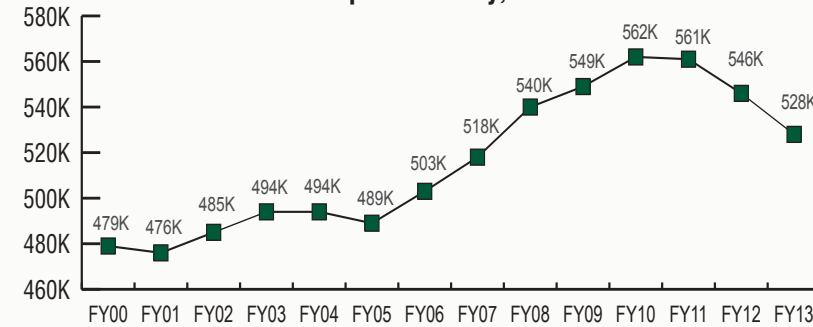

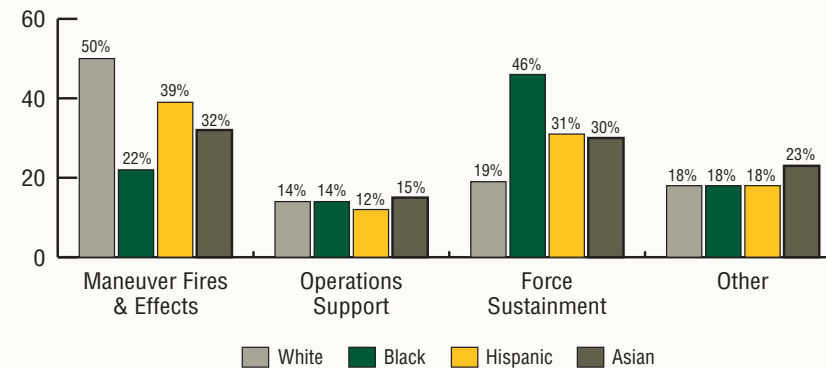

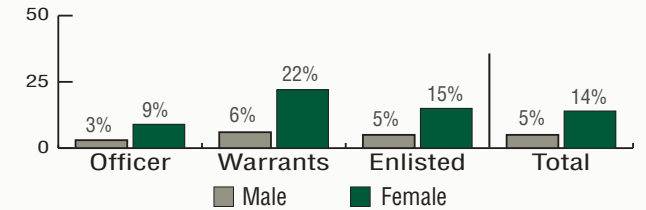
