

SUBJECT: Authorization to Implement Special Pay Rates for Information Technology Workers  
in the Defense Civilian Intelligence Personnel System (DCIPS)

On November 3, 2000, the Director, Office of Personnel Management (OPM) approved special salary rates for workers in certain information technology (IT) positions. The new IT special rates cover all GS-334 (Computer Specialist), GS-854 (Computer Engineer) and GS-1550 (Computer Scientist) positions in grades 5/7/9/11/12, effective January 2001.

In accordance with 10 U.S.C. §§1602 and 1603, you are delegated authority to implement special salary rates for equivalent IT positions within the DCIPS, consistent with the special salary rates approved by OPM. This delegation will remain in effect until superceded by an applicable DoD DCIPS subchapter in the DoD Civilian Personnel Manual, DoD 1400.25-M.
