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Notice of OPM Policy Information

Agencies: This Notice announces the interchange agreement between the Department of Defense Civilian Intelligence Personnel System and the Competitive Civil Service

Heads of Departments and Independent Establishments:

The U.S. Office of Personnel Management (OPM) has approved a 6-month extension of the personnel interchange agreement that permits movement between the competitive civil service and positions in the Military Departments (Army, Navy (includes the Marine Corps), and Air Force) covered under the Defense Civilian Intelligence Personnel System (DCIPS), formerly the Civilian Intelligence Personnel Management system (CIPMS). The Defense Security Service (DSS) is included in the personnel interchange agreement. Coverage under this agreement does not extend to DCIPS employees in other non-military components of the Department of Defense.

This extension is based on the results of the recent audit conducted December 22, 2009. The current DCIPS interchange agreement expires March 30, 2010. Attached is the new DCIPS agreement which expires on September 30, 2010.
