MEMORANDUM FOR Deputy Chief of Staff for G-2

SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority for Army Defense Civilian Intelligence Personnel System (DCIPS) Implementation

1. Reference

a. Under Secretary of Defense memorandum, dated July 14, 2008, subject: Approval of Final Interim Regulations for Implementation of the Common Defense Intelligence System Architecture (Enclosure 1).

b. Secretary of the Army memorandum, dated May 22, 2009, subject: Delegation of Authority for Army Defense Civilian Intelligence Personnel System (DCIPS) Implementation (Enclosure 2).

2. By reference 1b, the Secretary of the Army delegated to me the authority to implement and administer DCIPS for the Army and to issue Army interim DCIPS policy guidance. I hereby delegate to you the authority to adopt the final interim DoD DCIPS policy guidance issued under reference 1a. Additionally, I hereby delegate to you the authority to issue Army supplemental guidance where required, subject to my oversight and approval.

3. This authority must be exercised in strict compliance with applicable laws, rules, and regulations. The current DoD DCIPS final interim regulations were approved for use and transmitted by reference 1a.

4. This delegation is effective immediately and expires on May 22, 2011 unless earlier revoked.

MEMORANDUM FOR Secretary of the Army

SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority for Defense Civilian Intelligence Personnel System (DCIPS) Implementation

1. References:

a. Department of Defense Directive 1400.35, Defense Civilian Intelligence Personnel System (DCIPS), September 24, 2007.

b. Under Secretary of Defense, dated July 14, 2008, subject: Approval of Final Interim Regulations for Implementation of the Common Defense Intelligence System Architecture.

2. The Department of Defense (DoD) established DCIPS as the only civilian personnel system for defense intelligence positions, employees, and organizations designated as having an intelligence function in DoD Instruction 1400.25, Volume 2001, December 29, 2008. Consistent with this Instruction, Army is undertaking efforts to implement DCIPS in the near future.

3. Reference 1a provides that the Secretaries of the Military Departments shall supplement such DCIPS policies, procedures, requirements, and guidance, as appropriate, consistent with DoD policy. I respectfully request that you delegate to me the authority delegated to you in this issuance. I intend to further delegate this authority to the Deputy Chief of Staff G-2 with direction to implement and administer DCIPS for Army and issue necessary supplemental policy guidance to implement DCIPS in accordance with DoD direction. A delegation memorandum for your consideration and signature is enclosed.

4. Reference 1b approved final interim DCIPS regulations for use by Defense Intelligence components until such time as final separate issuances are issued. To implement DCIPS within the Army, we intend to initially adopt interim guidance, supplemented by Army guidance where needed, until DoD issues final regulations.

SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority for Army Defense Civilian Intelligence Personnel System (DCIPS) Implementation

1. Reference Under Secretary of Defense memorandum, dated July 14, 2008, subject: Approval of Final Interim Regulations for Implementation of the Common Defense Intelligence System Architecture.
2. I hereby delegate to you the authority to implement and administer DCIPS for Army and to issue Army interim DCIPS policy guidance. This authority may be further delegated to the Deputy Chief of Staff G-2, the Functional Chief for Military Intelligence.
3. The authority delegated must be exercised in strict compliance with applicable laws, rules, and regulations. Currently, DoD final interim regulations for implementation of DCIPS are found in referenced memorandum. I support your intent to initially adopt final DoD interim policy guidance and supplement with Army interim policy where required, until such time as DoD issues final policy guidance.
4. You are responsible for ensuring compliance on the use of this authority. I retain the authority to cancel, modify, or withdraw this delegation, in whole or in part, at any time. This delegation is effective immediately and expires two years from the date of this delegation.
